

Watch Competitive Esports LLC - Comprehensive Partner Terms of Service

Effective Date: February 05, 2026

1. Parties & Program Structure

These Terms govern participation in the Partner Program operated by Watch Competitive Esports LLC ("WCE"), which administers competitive league infrastructure, scheduling systems, compliance oversight, and communications for 1v1Me League Players. Participation as a Partner constitutes participation as an official 1v1Me League Player.

2. Independent Contractor Status

Partners participate strictly as independent contractors. Nothing herein creates employment, agency, partnership, joint venture, or fiduciary relationships. Participation is a revocable privilege.

3. Eligibility & Compliance

Partners must be at least 18 years old and legally permitted to contract. Partners must comply with all applicable laws and platform rules. WCE reserves sole discretion over eligibility and continued participation.

4. Performance & Conduct Standards

Partners must attend matches punctually, maintain availability, uphold competitive integrity, comply with anti-fraud standards, and conduct themselves professionally. WCE may evaluate performance using any metrics deemed appropriate.

5. Compensation & Modifications

Compensation may include revenue share or incentive-based payments. There is no guaranteed income or scheduling volume. WCE may modify compensation structures at its sole discretion.

6. Discretionary Suspension & Termination

WCE reserves the absolute right, at any time and for any reason or no reason, to suspend, restrict, modify, or terminate a Partner's participation. Grounds may include performance, inactivity, compliance risk, brand protection, integrity concerns, or operational restructuring. No notice is required unless mandated by law.

7. Intellectual Property & Publicity Rights

Partners grant WCE a worldwide, royalty-free license to use their gamer tag, likeness, gameplay footage, voice, and match recordings for promotional, broadcast, operational, and marketing purposes.

8. Confidentiality

Partners agree not to disclose non-public business information, payout formulas, league processes, or internal communications.

9. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, WCE shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages. Total liability shall not exceed compensation paid to the Partner in the three months preceding the claim.

10. Indemnification

Partners agree to indemnify and hold harmless WCE and its affiliates from claims arising from misconduct, fraud, legal violations, or breach of these Terms.

11. Mandatory Arbitration & Class Action Waiver

Any dispute arising out of or relating to these Terms shall be resolved exclusively through binding arbitration administered under the Federal Arbitration Act in New Jersey. Arbitration shall be conducted individually; class, collective, or representative actions are expressly waived. The arbitrator shall have exclusive authority to resolve disputes regarding arbitrability. Judgment upon award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

12. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

13. Modifications

WCE may update these Terms at any time. Continued participation constitutes acceptance of revised Terms.
